The Missouri FFA Association is seeking applicants for experience-based interns to assist with media needs for the 2025 Missouri FFA State Convention. The media team provides coverage ranging from photo and video to social media and written content throughout the duration of State FFA Convention. These positions are unpaid and meant to provide experience and resume building opportunities to those interested.

Position Description: Missouri FFA Media Intern **Location:** Hearnes Center - Columbia, Mo.

Responsibilities: Under the direction of the Director of Communications and Social Media Manager, the interns in this position will assist with a broad range of tasks, including the development of social media posts, video and reels content, photography, written content and other duties as assigned. Selected interns will be placed on teams that focus on a specific area of Convention media coverage based on skills and expertise.

Qualifications: We are accepting two tiers of applicants for internship roles. High School Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors will be considered for content team member positions based on experience and skillset. College-level applicants will be considered for team lead positions. All applicants should have an interest and/or experience in agricultural communications, FFA, marketing, social media or similar areas.

Expectations: Selected interns are expected to be available at State Convention April 23-25, 2025. Interns will be responsible for their own transportation and lodging at Convention.
